[Ice People](#) Discoveries Make Worldwide Headlines

In [Ice People](#), documentary filmmaker Anne Aghion follows research geologists Dr. Allan Ashworth and Dr. Adam Lewis for months, as they pick their way across Antarctica's interior dry valleys, eventually discovering--in front of Aghion's camera!--plant and animal fossils that prove the ice shelf at the bottom of the world was once green.

News reports in [The Associated Press](#) and [The Telegraph](#) (UK) indicate the discoveries are significant in determining causes and effects of climate change, including global warming--which, as they point out, is the reversal of the big freeze that created Antarctica's ice shelf 14-million years ago.

[Ice People](#), not yet released in America, is an important addition to the [list](#) of documentaries--[An Inconvenient Truth](#) and [The 11th Hour](#) among them--that raise public awareness about the dangers of global warming.
